- ✓ **At each event from February onwards**, the plan is to offer biscuits, tea & coffee, and these will only be charged at cost - so it's no more expensive than being at home ... *but you'll be enjoying your biscuit and cuppa with old (and new?) friends in the lovely warm and welcoming atmosphere of our beautiful Village Hall*
